(May I rest/ Let me sleep/ I find peace)
- as a blessing, to be sung over someone troubled or disturbed.
(May you rest/ Go to sleep/ Hold your peace)
- at the conclusion of night prayers, sung by all.
(May we rest/ Let us sleep/ We find peace)
- at a funeral or memorial service.
(May (s)he rest/ Let her(him) sleep/ Rest in peace)
